Enhanced Audit Requirements	Louise
Due to a change in regulation, Porter Garland require us to conduct a more rigourous audit process if we wish to stay with them. This will incur an additional charge of £900 incl VAT. This will bring our total costs for accountancy and audit to £2200. Our company articles requires us to conduct an audit, however our turnover is low enough that there is no legal requirement for us to conduct one other than the company articles. Louise recommends that we continue with Porter Garland and the enhanced audit. If we do this, we will need to inform Porter Garland by February.	
All present agreed to go ahead with the enhanced audit for the current financial year, then raise this as a point for discussion in the AGM. Louise to inform Porter Garland that we wish to have the enhanced audit.	
Savings Accounts	
Mark, Tristan and Louise signed a request to open a savings account for the company balance. The interest income from this will require us to register for corporation tax. This will be handled by Porter Garland.
